



## RULES

1. All members of the public are invited to submit exhibits at EGLINTON FLOWER SHOW.
2. Entry Fee 50p per exhibit in all adult classes, 15p per exhibit in children's classes. Entry fee must accompany entry form.
3. An exhibitor who wins more than one prize in any class will only be awarded the points towards a trophy for the highest prize.
4. Entries close at 10.00am on the morning of the show. No entries will be accepted after this time.
5. First prize counts as four points, second prize as three points, third prize as two points and highly commended as one point.
6. No prize will be awarded, if in the opinion of the judges, an exhibit fails to reach a certain standard of excellence expected.
7. The decision of the judge will in all cases be final.
8. In Handicraft Section, all exhibits must be executed within 12 months prior to the date of the show.
9. Exhibits must be produced / grown by the exhibitor or been the property of the exhibitor for at least two months prior to The Show
10. Personal identification marks, signatures etc must be covered prior to the exhibit being staged.
11. Labels will be issued for each exhibit on receipt of entry form and entry fee and must be attached to the exhibits before entering the show room. This rule must be strictly observed. 12. Exhibits must be staged by 11.00am on the morning of the show and ready for judging by 11.15am when only Judges and Stewards will be allowed to remain in the room. No exhibit will be accepted after 11.00am.
13. Exhibitors are requested to provide their own vases, glass jars etc and to name all exhibits as far as possible.
14. All Cups and Prizes of like sort should be returned to the Show Secretary not later than 10<sup>th</sup> August 2007. Written certificate to this effect to be signed on receipt of trophy.
15. While the committee will exercise every care, all exhibits, personal property, etc will be at the risk of the exhibitors. The Committee will not be liable for compensation for loss or damage by theft or any cause whatsoever.
16. Exhibits may not be removed from The Show before 3.30pm. Any complaint or objection with regard to exhibits or any matter MUST be made in writing to the Secretary not later than 6.30pm on the day of the show and be accompanied by a fee of £1.00 which will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
17. No alteration will be allowed in rules once made, except at the Annual General Meeting for revising the schedule, to be held in October each year.
18. Entries will not be accepted from professionals in their own subject.

# ENTRIES

Please check your entry / entries carefully against details in the schedule

Entries have in the past been disqualified because they have not met the requirements of the schedule, eg. Three stems entered whereas the schedule asked for four stems

It seems a shame to lose points in this way!

When your entry form is completed please take or send it to The Secretary so that the required labels may be filled in.

The return of your form EARLY avoids delays on the morning of the show.

Entry forms must be submitted by 10.00am

Your competition entries should be placed in the show before 11.00am and should be collected after 3.30pm on the day of the show
