# Yorkshire Teacake - recipe for competition 83.

Oven Temperature: 180 c / 350 f / gas mark 4

Container: 2 lb loaf tin

## **Ingredients**

350 g (12 oz ) mixed dried fruit

225 g (8 oz ) SR flour

200 ml (7 Fl oz ) cold tea (Earl Grey is best)

110 g ( 4 oz ) dark brown sugar

50 g (2 oz) glace cherries

1 egg, beaten

## **Method**

- 1 Put fruit, cherries and sugar in a bowl. Pour over the cold tea and soak overnight .
- 2 Add egg and flour and mix well.
- 3 Put into lined tin and bake for 1 hour approx.
- 4 Test with a skewer to check thoroughly cooked

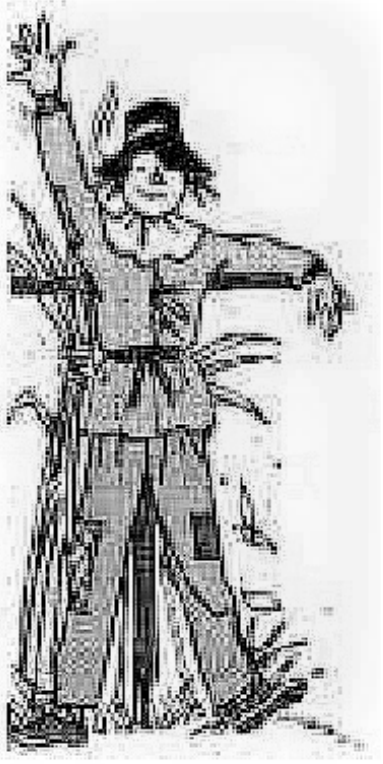
